

Rutgers, The State University of NJ Robert Wood Johnson Medical School

Designed for high-achieving premedical students, the BA/MD program gives students the opportunity to incorporate medical school courses into their undergraduate program of study in their junior and senior years. Students will receive RU credit for many of the medical school courses taken.

Benefits of the program include:

- Students attend the first year of medical school while paying Rutgers tuition;
- Students in the BA/MD program do not have to take the MCAT exam.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- They must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
- They must have completed 4 semesters of college, with a minimum of 60 credits;
- As a minimum, they must be enrolled for one year at RU, earning 30 credits;
- A minimum GPA of 3.5 at Rutgers is required;
- Two semesters of General Biology, two semesters of General Chemistry, two semesters of Organic Chemistry, all with labs, one semester of college-level Mathematics, and one semester of English must be completed;
- If AP or transfer credit was granted for General Biology, two other upper-level biology courses are required to be taken at Rutgers University;
- Successful applicants are those who have demonstrated interests aside from the study of medicine that they have pursued in depth and for whom there is good evidence that they would use the time provided by the program productively.

The application can be obtained at the Health Professions Office on your campus and without exception, must be submitted by May 25th. In addition to the application, a minimum of 5 letters of recommendation must be submitted on behalf of the applicant to the BA/MD office. These must include a minimum of two letters from Rutgers faculty members in science or mathematics courses and a minimum of two letters from Rutgers faculty in non-science courses. Recommendations from teaching assistants are acceptable.
